Agro- and environmental sciences

- France is the 8th agricultural power (total contribution to agricultural production)
 - √ +400 000 farms in mainland France
 - √ ~300 000 km² devoted to agricultural activity (+50% territory)
 - ✓ Organic farming represents 10% of French agricultural operations
- Forests: 31% of the French territory (↗); the wood industry generates 60 billions € revenues/year & +400 000 jobs
- The French territory is very diverse, offering a rich array of ecosystems and biodiversity

→ Study programmes and research connected to agrosciences, forestry, environmental sciences, climate change, development studies are numerous!





As a full-time student

The French State finances a large part of the tuition fees in **public universities**.

Level	Yearly tuition fees 2023-2024
Licence (Bachelor's degree)	170 € - 4 350 CZK
Master (Master's degree)	243 € - 6 200 CZK
Engineering schools	601 € - 15 000 CZK

Significant investments



France spends 48 billion €/year on research, which is 2.24% of its GDP

417 000+ people are involved in research

- 40% work in the public sector
- 60% work in the private sector








What is a PhD in France?

A doctoral candidate is...



An early career researcher

doing full-time research in an academic research lab

Enrolled in a doctoral programme

offered by a doctoral school, with a supervisor providing personalized mentorship, and with an annual follow-up committee

Average duration

3 or 4 years

What is a PhD in France?

The different types of doctorate

Standard doctorate

one or two supervisor(s) from the same academic research lab/center as the PhD candidate → one French doctorate degree

In-company doctorate (CIFRE)

2 supervisors (including one in a company) + work contract with the company, 1 academic research lab/center → one French doctorate degree



International co-supervision

- 2 supervisors (in France and in another country), 1 French university
- → one French doctorate degree

International joint doctorate, cotutelle

- 2 supervisors, 2 academic host research labs, 2 universities in 2 countries
- → two joint doctorate degrees

Barrande Fellowships Programme

- Mobility programme that supports PhD mobility between France and the Czech Republic, in both directions
- Partnership between the MŠMT and the French Embassy
- Two types of mobility:
- Short-term mobility (1 to 3 months)
- Mobility in the frame of a co-tutelle (5 months per year over 3 years)
- ~1700 euros per month
- All disciplines, with special attention given to projects in the field of energy, environmental sciences and IT
- Between 20 and 30 laureates every year. 2023: 29 laureates





Deadline: every year, late January/early February

France Excellence Eiffel PhD

 For a doctorate: finance the mobility over 12 months, 18 months or 36 months (for PhD) in the frame of a joint supervision or co-supervised doctorate.



- Objective: aim for the excellence of students/ PhD students / support the structuring of a genuine international policy for French higher education institutions / promote the French higher education institutions internationally.
- Target areas: Science and Technology: Biology and Health, Ecological transition, Mathematics and Digital, Engineering sciences -Humanities and Social sciences: History, French language and civilization, Law and Political science, Economics and Management
- Monthly allowance of 1 700 € (since January 2021). In addition, other expenses are covered such as the international trip to France, social security, cultural activities, housing financial help under specific conditions.
- 1 129 Eiffel doctorate laureates since 2005. Next Call: October, 2024

Follow-up programme

MOPGA PROGRAMME

- Started in 2017
- o Programme for :
 - Students: Master and PhD
 - Researchers: Post-doc, advanced researchers
- Climate change topics (climate change & sustainability sciences, earth system sciences, energy transition, societal challenges on environmental issues, One Health)
- 10 calls since 2017
- New call in 2024: for Post-doc, until January 2025
- Entirely financed by France, 2500€/ month

- 7 categories (23 laureates in 2023) chemistry, nuclear sciences, computer science, pharmacy, medicine, social sciences and the humanities, environment and climate change
- In partnership with companies, foundations...
- → Financial reward (up to 80K czk) & scholarship to spend a month in a French research lab
