

SUPPORT FOR PARTICIPANTS WITH PHYSICAL, MENTAL OR HEALTH DISADVANTAGES (INCLUSION SUPPORT)

The amount of financial support represents **100 % of the real costs** related to the participant's disadvantage.

Financial support for inclusion is used to support a participant who, due to his/her disadvantages, would not be able to go on mobility without the additional financial support needed. Inclusion support aims to cover the specific costs required as a result of the participant's specific disadvantage. Such costs may include personal assistance, a wheelchair, accessible accommodation, etc.

To receive inclusion support, the participant must complete an application form describing the costs required and the amount. All costs must be supported by receipts that prove eligibility.

Application for inclusion support:

1. The participant completes the application for inclusion support available on the National Agency/the home university website. Participant completes Part B – Minimum Requirements.
2. Provide relevant confirmation to the application:
 - a current medical report showing entitlement to the costs claimed
 - a copy of the Disability Card ZTP (if the participant has one) - a signed Learning Agreement for the study stay/traineeship
 - Letter of Acceptance from the receiving institution confirming the student's acceptance and understanding of his/her medical condition
3. The Erasmus+ coordinator at the HEI will check the information filled in by the participant and the required certificates to see if they justify the costs requested.
4. Approval of the application:
 - up to EUR 3 000 - approval at university level
 - above EUR 3 000 or in case of assistance - approval at the level of the National Agency (DZS)

During the mobility, the participant shall keep accounting receipts for approved expenses. Upon return, the participant, in cooperation with the coordinator, will make an accounting based on the documentation of all accounting documents.

Examples of claimable costs:

- barrier-free accommodation
- medical visits
- assistance services
- specially adapted study materials
- food in case of specific dietary requirements
- transport
- delivery services
- sending oversized packages (transport of medical supplies, etc.)
- psychotherapeutic/therapeutic services abroad
