ECTS credits:

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semester = 30 credits

All study programmes at Mendel University in Brno are measured in terms of ECTS credits. All courses have a number of credits allocated reflecting students workload that an average student will need to achieve expected learning outcomes.

One credit stands for 28 hours of total study time. Standard academic year is based on 60 ECTS, which is 1680 hours of student workload. Individual student can differ from this standard according to their capacities, skills, foreknowledge, and efforts.
