Selection Process

Depending on the funds allocated, faculties will be assigned several mobilities at the time of the call for applications, with an average length of 5 days (+ 2 travel days).

The evaluation (points assignment) is the responsibility of the faculty vice-dean for international affairs or their designated representative. This person is also authorized to justify the scoring upon request from the employee. The results will be sent to faculties after the end of the selection process, recorded by the REK IRO, and published on the OMVI website.

Note: Doctoral students may also carry out Erasmus+ mobilities in the form of traineeships (minimum duration of 2 months).

Procedure in four steps

- 1) Call for Applications mass email to employees, news post on the IRO website
- 2) Deadline: 21 April 2025 to complete online applications



- 3) IRO sends vice-deans the list of applicants from their faculty along with the number of allocated mobilities
- 4) Deadline: 4 May 2025 for evaluation evaluators send completed evaluation table to IRO
- 5) From 12 May 2025 announcement of results: IRO compiles the final overview and informs successful applicants of their allocation. All applicants are notified of the results and faculties receive a summary of allocated mobilities, which will also be published on the IRO website.

Teaching and Training Mobilities: Recognized Activities – Summary

- ♣ STA Teaching: This activity allows academic staff of higher education institutions or professionals from enterprises to teach at a partner foreign higher education institution. The mobility can take place in any field/academic discipline.
- ♣ STT Training: This activity supports the professional development of higher education staff through training abroad (excluding conferences), staff shadowing, participation in workshops or BIPs, attendance of lectures or professional courses at a partner higher education institution or another relevant organization abroad.
- ♣ STT Language Course Abroad
