


# Bringing Technological Industrial Products to Market from Innovation to Commercialization

## Why UCN Aalborg?

Aalborg is an ideal location for this program because:

## How to get there?

Participants can fly to Aalborg Airport (AAL) from major European hubs. Direct flights are available from Amsterdam, while connecting flights via Copenhagen or Amsterdam serves many eurupean cities. The flight durations vary, typically ranging from 1.5 to 5 hours depending on the layovers.

For those preferring green travel, several international bus services, such as FlixBus, operate routes to Aalborg as well as trains with DSB and DB. Both often involves transfers in intermediary cities.

From the airport it is esay to find public transportation at <u>Rejseplanen.dk</u> or taxi which will take you to the city center in aproximatly 10-15 minutes.
