

## **SUPPORT FOR PARTICIPANTS WITH PHYSICAL, MENTAL, OR HEALTH DISABILITIES (INCLUSION SUPPORT)**

The amount of financial support covers **100 % of the real costs** related to the participant's disability.

Inclusion financial support is intended to assist participants who, due to their disability, would be unable to travel for mobility without additional financial support. The goal of inclusion support is to cover the specific costs resulting from the participant's disability. These costs may include personal assistance, barrier-free accommodation, etc.

To receive inclusion support, the participant must complete an application describing the required costs and their amount. All costs must be substantiated with confirmation documents that prove entitlement to the costs.

### **Application for inclusion support:**

1. The participant fills out the inclusion support application available on the website of National Agency/at their home university. The participant fills in section B, C, D, E and F – minimum requirements.
2. They provide the relevant documentation for the application:
  - a current medical report confirming entitlement to the requested costs
    - a copy of the ZTP card (if the participant has one) – signed Mobility Agreement
  - an acceptance letter from the receiving institution confirming the acceptance of the participant and understanding of their health condition.
3. The Erasmus+ program coordinator at the university will review the information provided by the participant and the required confirmations to determine if they justify the requested costs.
4. Approval of the application:
  - up to 3,000 EUR – approval at the university level,
  - over 3,000 EUR or in case of assistance – approval at the National Agency level.

During the mobility, the participant keeps all receipts for approved costs. After returning, the participant, in collaboration with the coordinator, will settle the expenses based on the submitted receipts.

### **Examples of eligible costs:**

- barrier-free accommodation
- doctor's visits
- assistance services
- food in the case of specific dietary requirements
- transportation
- delivery services
- sending oversized packages (transport of medical materials, etc.)
- psychotherapeutic/therapeutic services abroad
