The Summer School combines:

Accommodation

The Summer School will take place at:
Faculty of Technical Sciences Čačak

Svetog Save 65, Čačak, Serbia

Participants will be accommodated in the **student dormitory** located next to the Faculty and close to the Morava river promenade.

Accommodation includes:

Educational institutions, research facilities, and local landmarks will also be included in the cultural programme to provide participants with a broader perspective on Serbian academic and cultural life.



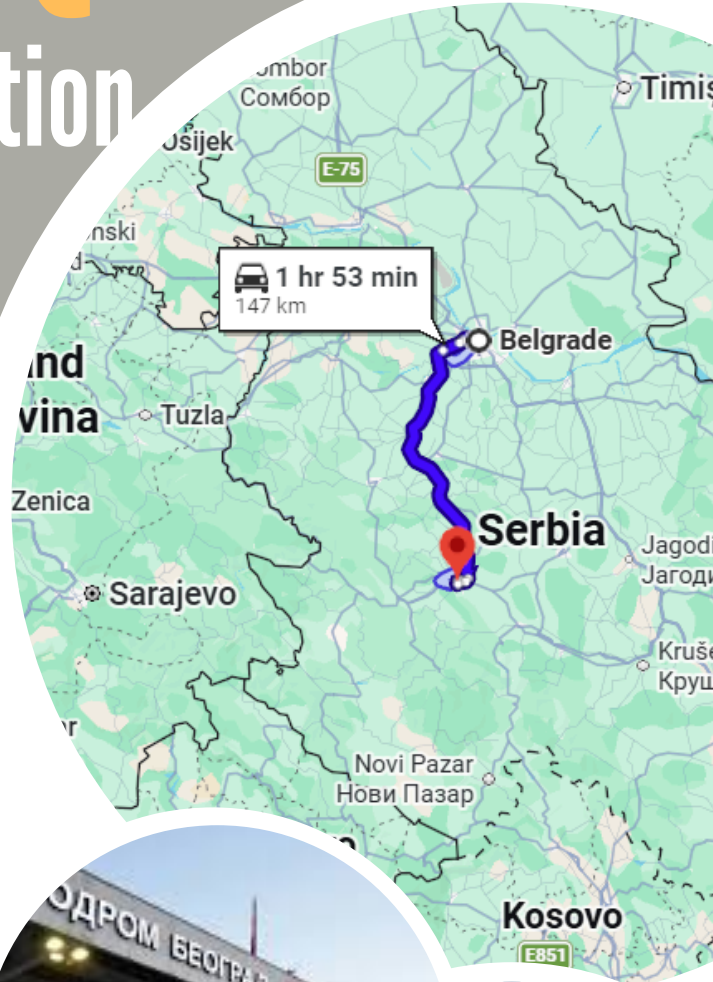

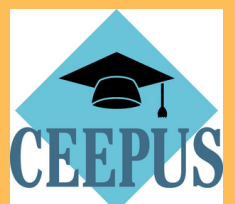
